Why is the West End Development needed?

A church has stood on this site for more than 900 years during which time it has fulfilled a pivotal role in the spiritual, architectural and cultural life of Madingley. It is now time for the church to improve its interior space to enable this much loved historic building to continue to serve and improve its hospitality to the local community and to visitors from far and wide as well as securing its usability for future generations and making it fit for the 21st century.


What is the West End Development project?

The West End Development will provide:

- A servery and sink so that refreshments can be available after services, at concerts and social occasions.
- An accessible toilet, acoustically separate from the rest of the church; a balcony, access to the bell chamber and a display unit for our historic cherubim.
- Improved internal planning to enable social events, concerts, exhibitions and outreach sessions to take place.
- A new vestry to improve the efficiency of preparing for and clearing away after our services.
- Improved equality of access for everyone.

Has the project started?

- Our church architect has designed a scheme which is complementary to the architecture of this Grade 2* listed building in the Madingley conservation area.
- Plans are in place to monitor and secure archaeology and ecology.
- We have obtained planning permission from South Cambridgeshire District Council and have the authorisation of the Diocese of Ely.
- We have commenced a fund raising scheme.
